Module 1: family

1-The importance of a family:

- * Healthy families are the backbone of a healthy society

Ways to strengthen family bonds.

Causes of generation gap:

- Lack of understanding: this is due to social changes, different languages and the invasion of social media
- Parents often do not tolerate mistakes and tend to punish their children.
- Comparing children to each other or even to how you were as a child is another reason the gap becomes wide.
- Parents expect their children to be replicas of themselves.
- Due to busy daily life and stress, parents often find themselves too tired to spend enough time with their kids every day



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Ways to avoid generation gap:

- 1) Communication plays an important role in bridging gaps between parents and children.
- 2) Open-mindedness means widening your horizons and looking at things with a new perspective. This helps to understand the children's priorities and habits.
- 3) Parents have to let their children voice their opinions and listen to what they are saying, without interrupting them.
- 4) Parents should be friends with their children
- 5) Love has a way of crossing boundaries and bringing people together.
- 6) Instead of forcing children into a particular way of thinking, parents should learn to compromise when possible.

How children should deal with their parents

- 1) Children must listen and respond calmly when their parents say something upsetting
- 2) Children must obey all of your parents' rules in order to help build trust
- 3) Children should explain how they feel to help their parents understand them
- 4) After a fight, children should go to their room or go for a walk-in order to think about what happened and release any negative emotions

How parents should deal with their children

- 1) Children watch very carefully everything their parents do therefore parents should be a good role model
- 2) Parents should boost their children's self-esteem by praising them wisely, focusing on their strengths and avoiding belittling
- 3) It's extremely rewarding for parents to schedule together time with their kids
- 4) Parents should be a safe haven for their children by being sensitive to their needs
- 5) Parents should love their children unconditionally and water their offspring's lives with affection as a nourishment



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Module 2: philanthropy

Ways to raise money:

- **Car boot sale:** an event in a public place where people sell their unwanted possessions, often from the backs of their cars.
- **T-shirt fundraising:** selling customized clothes
- **Benefit concert:** a show that is held for a charitable purpose
- **Run a raffle:** an activity in which people buy tickets with different numbers, some of which are later chosen to win prizes, that is organized to make money for a good social purpose
- **Charity auction:** a usually public sale of goods or property, where people make higher and higher bids (= offers of money) for each thing, until the thing is sold to the person who will pay most

The importance of volunteerism:

- Volunteering is a great way to establish new relationships and strengthen the bonds with your community
- Volunteering can help you learn new skills, gain experience and even qualifications.
- Volunteering can help you gain confidence by giving you the chance to try something new and build a real sense of achievement.
- volunteering can lead to the release of endorphins which increases feelings of pleasure and well-being and reduces pain and discomfort.
- volunteering can have a real and valuable positive effect on people, communities, and society in general.

The benefits of tolerance:

- Tolerance allows people of different backgrounds, religions, and races to work and live together, and this breeds unity
- In a tolerant country, every citizen remains loyal to his country and is willing to make sacrifices for the sake of the country.



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- Being able to accept one another's differences can have positive effect on one's wellbeing.
- Being tolerant removes one's self-imposed barriers and allows one to think more broadly and enjoy greater inner peace.

The disadvantages of intolerance:

- Intolerance breeds hatred, hatred leads to distrust, distrust causes disunity.
- Where there is discrimination, there cannot be peace. Intolerance leads to infighting, violence and instability as different groups resort to force and aggression against each other or the state.
- Discrimination makes miserable lives for not just those discriminated against, but everyone in the society
- If, in a nation, instead of acceptance there is discrimination, that nation cannot flourish
