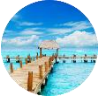

*Aquaman* is the cinematic equivalent of a dish of a superhero movie into which many **ingredients** has been thrown. Bits of it are hard to digest, bits are flaky, but it has plenty of flavor. Much of the film takes place **underwater**. Director James Wan manages to create a real Arthurian epic. The story opened on a **stormy** night in Maine in 1985 as lighthouse keeper Thomas Curry (Temuera Morrison) saw a stranded mermaid-like woman on the rocks, the beautiful Atlanta, Queen of Atlantis (Nicole Kidman). She has fled her home kingdom to avoid an **arranged** marriage. she **fell** in love with him. "I was the product of the love that never should have been," Aquaman (Jason Momoa) tells us in a voice-over. The filmmakers answer questions **that** audiences are bound to ask; human beings have been **polluting** the oceans, sending their nuclear submarines too close to the marine world. Their behavior gives Orm the excuse to try to wage a war **against** them.
