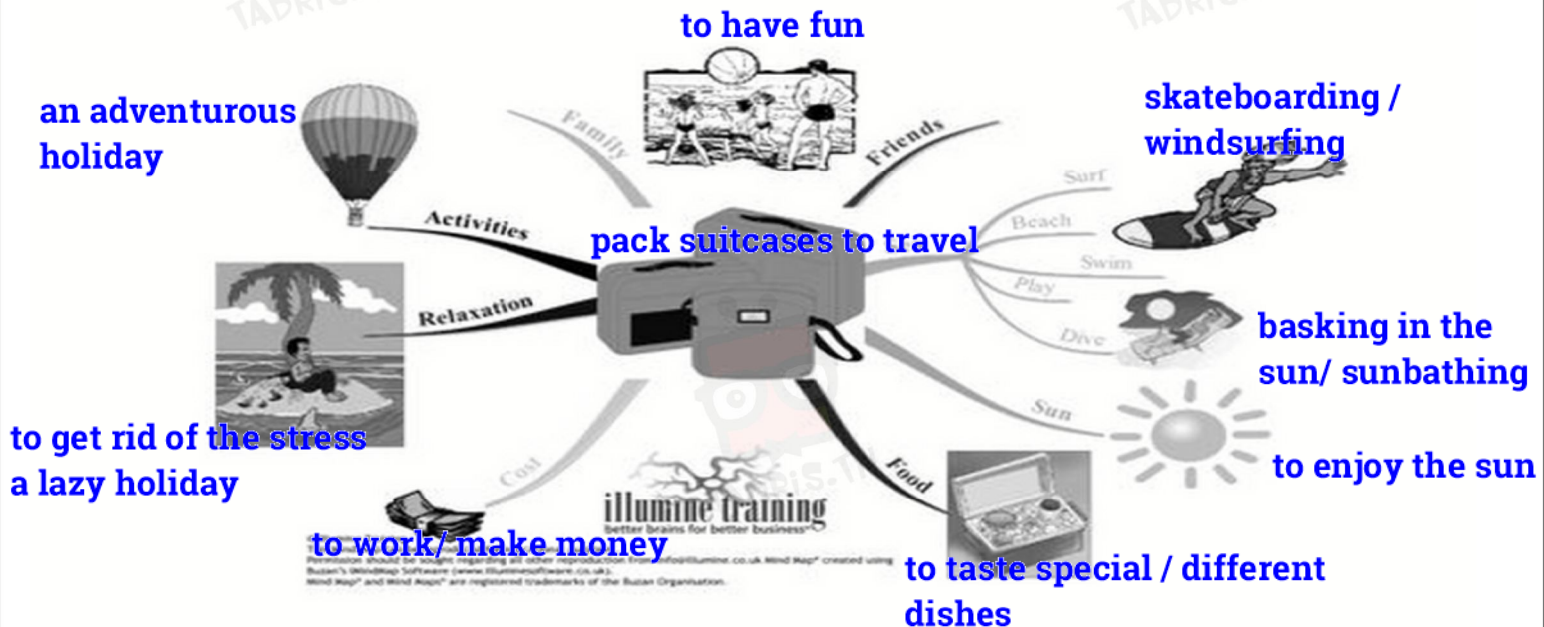

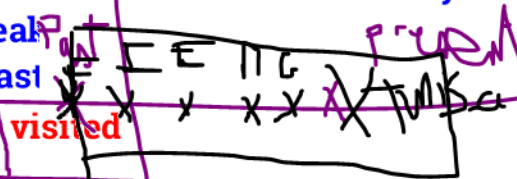

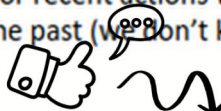

The Present Perfect: Form: subject +/ + past participle

The Present perfect - is used to talk about a definite action in the past

The Past Simple -is used for recent actions which took place at an indefinite time in the past (we don't know the exact time)

s+ hasn't/ haven't+ pp
